We always recommend taking your new bow to a professional archery pro shop for the initial setup. HOWEVER, many archery shops will not be happy that you purchased a bow online. If they tell you something is wrong and that you should return it. CONTACT US FIRST. As 9/10s they are only saying that as they want you to buy from them.

ADJUSTING DRAW WEIGHT

This bow has approx. 40lb-60lb weight adjustment range. Adjust the draw weight by either loosing or tightening the bolts on the limb pockets that fasten the limbs to the riser. Turn the bolts clockwise to increase draw weight and counter-clockwise to decrease the draw weight. ALWAYS MAKE SURE TO ADJUST BOTH BOLTS EVENLY, AND NEVER LOOSEN MORE THAN 10 TURNS out from all the way in!

ADJUSTING DRAW LENGTH

You can adjust the draw length using the chart below. When adjusting draw length, first loosen the lock screw in the middle of the cam, then remove the other draw length screw completely. Next, turn the module to the desired draw length hole then reinstall the draw length screw. Place blue lock tight on both screws to prevent them from vibrating loose, then tighten them snug. Must be done to both sides. Use the chart below to set your draw length. (When holding the bow properly, the hole closest to the archer is #1 while the hole closest to the riser is #12)
